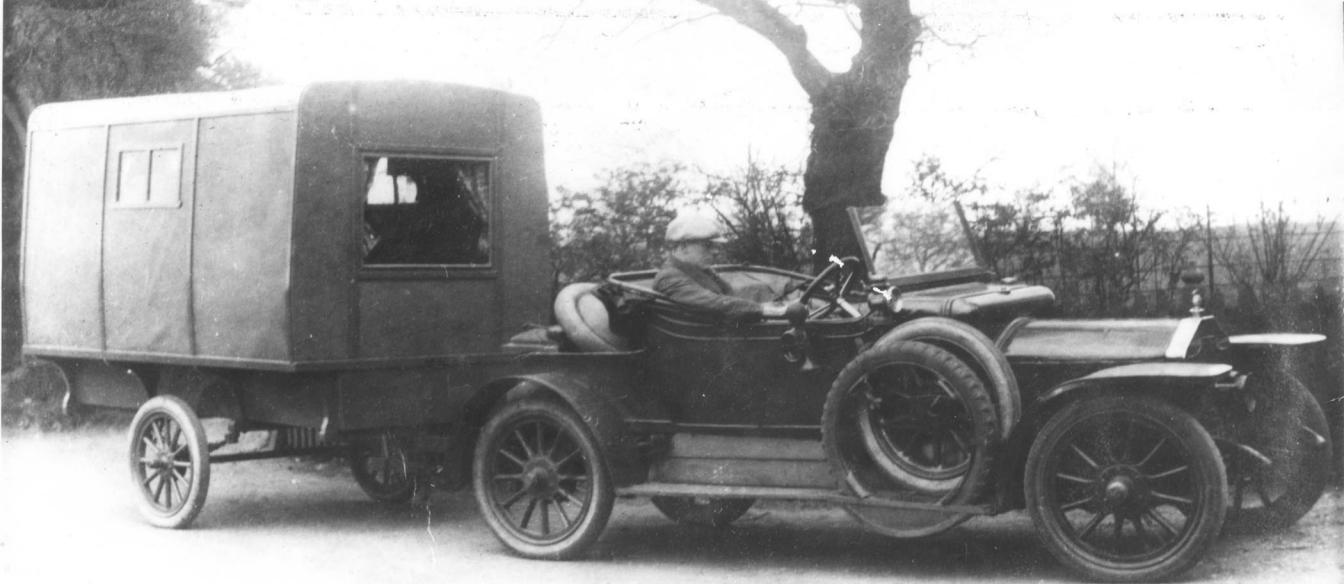

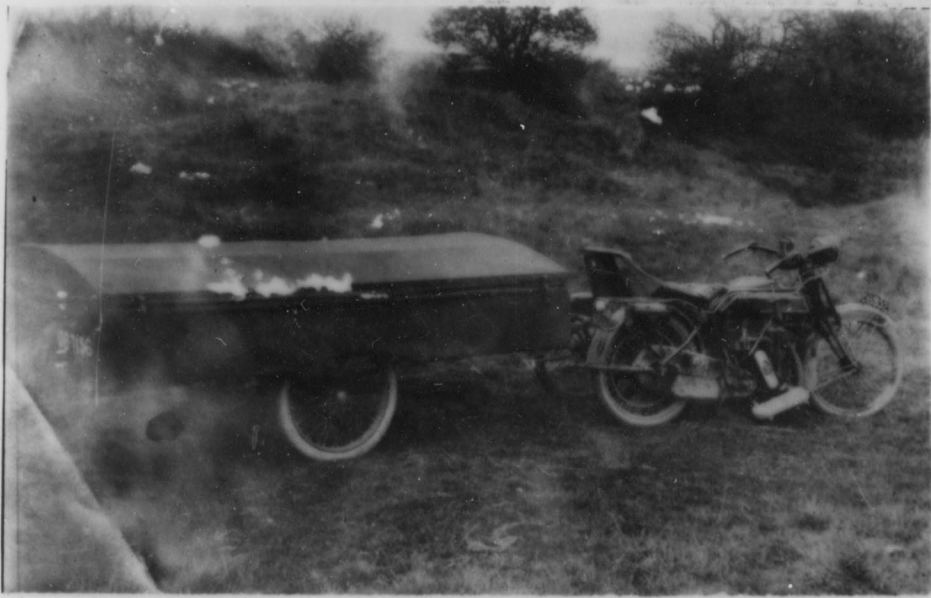

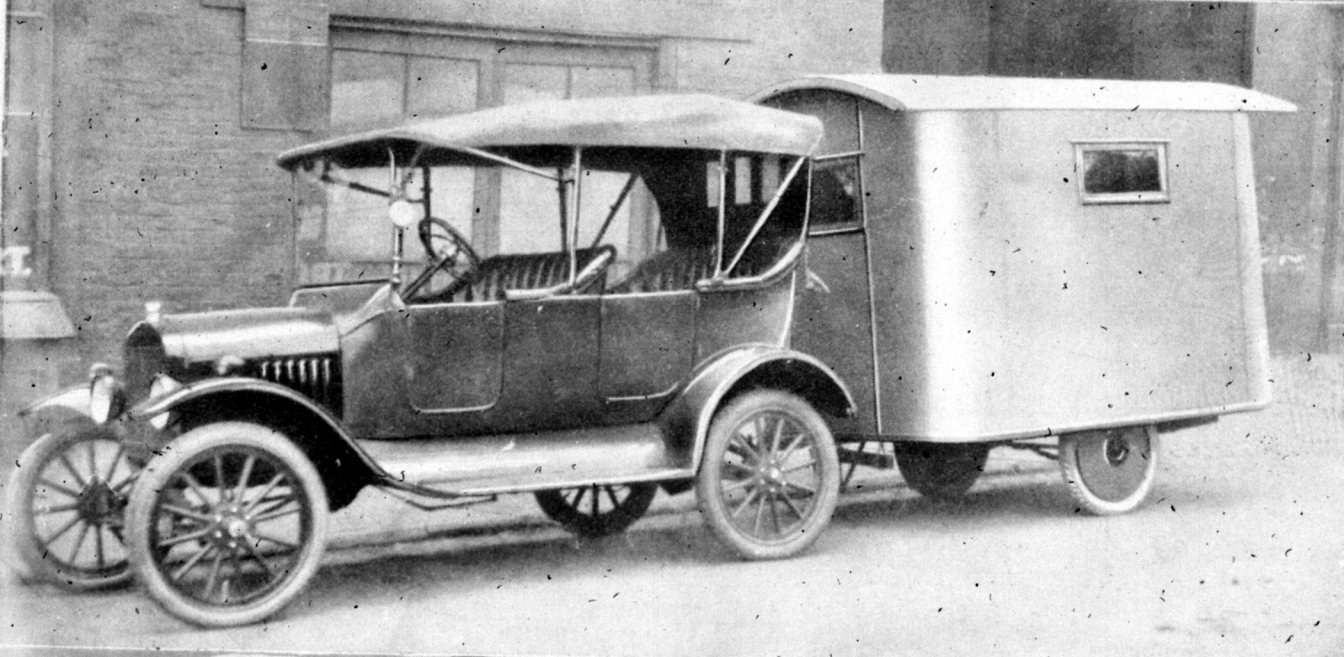

The style continued until 1932. Body plywood or steel coated plywood."

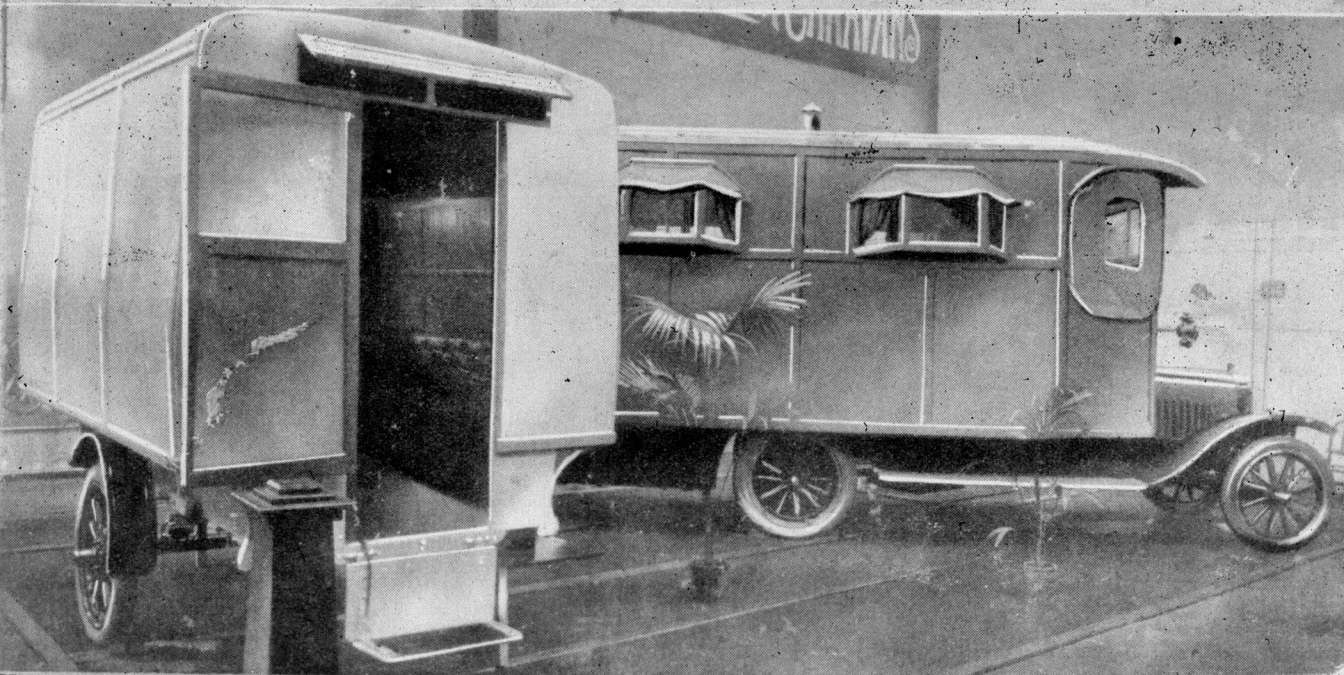
