CI CARAVAN'S £2 MILLION DEVELOPMENT:- Body panel construction for CI's Sprite, Eccles and Europa brands is to be standardised on bonded sandwich construction for side and end panels. Floors use a similar technique but to a different specification. Panel production is handled by twin manufacturing units controlled by micro-chip and combining automatic spraying of the bonding agent with large vacuum presses.
